Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Alleluia! What a joy to shout and sing the resurrection after the solemnity of Lent. Christ was crucified and buried, but he is no longer there. His body is not in the tomb. He is alive, having conquered death and all our enemies. His victory resounds to eternity, and it is our victory by faith in Him. Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! 


