
The first Sunday of each month the Mite box will be available for you to bring your Mites. (suggestion put your coins in a zip lock bag - keep your mite box).

From the Pastor's Desk

Happy February—month #4 in Greeley for the Vanderhydes! Thank you again for your warm welcome and continued love and support. We are glad to be here, and I am glad to be your pastor. Much remains for me to learn about our church and school, and I welcome your help. If you are interested in meeting with me, please call the office or send an email so we can set up an appointment (jvanderhyde@tlgreeley.com).

This month, we transition from Epiphany to Lent, from the Season of Light to a season of repentance. And the contrast is stark. Epiphany will crescendo with Transfiguration Sunday on February 11th as we ascend the mountain with Peter, James, and John to see Jesus shining, too bright for human eyes. A few days later, purest light gives way to charcoal ashes as we are marked with a cross to remember our mortality: “Dust you are; to dust you shall return.” The contrast might be explained like this: now that the eyes of our hearts have been strengthened to see Christ, we turn to examine ourselves, and His Light exposes our sin and weakness. Now, we begin a Lenten journey of repentance, discipline, and faith with Christ as our guide.

The word “Lent” comes from the Old English “lencten”: to lengthen. As the days lengthen and the dead of winter gives way to spring, we prepare our hearts for the Easter celebration of Christ’s resurrection from the dead. The resurrection of Christ is everything for Christians. It means our own resurrection and purification from sin in Christ. So why not just hang out until the Last Day? Why do we need repentance and discipline? Why not skip to Easter? Why Lent? Because the battle for faith is not over yet. The devil, the world, and our sinful flesh conspire to make “shipwreck of our faith” (1 Timothy 1:19)—to lure our attention away from Christ. Lent is an opportunity to recover our attention and direct it Godward in Christ. Lenten discipline aims to strengthen faith.

Lent is patterned after the discipline of Jesus, who fasted and prayed in the wilderness for forty days. During Lent, we spend forty days (not including Sundays) with him in the wilderness. The wilderness is a place of simplicity, separated from the routines and cares of daily life. It is a space in which, through fasting and prayer, to reshape habits and routines and reorient our attention toward God in Christ. May God strengthen and fortify us during this Lenten season as we fix “our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith” (Hebrews 12:3).

- Meeting opened with prayer by Pastor and devotion by Angela.
- Minutes: December minutes were approved via email by Council members prior to this meeting
- Welcomed and formally introduced new Council members: Londa, Renee, Randy, Scott, and Matthew.
- Established devotion schedule for monthly meeting.
- Set annual joint meeting with Board of Elders and Council for March 9, 2024, at 8:00 am in the Narthex Lounge.
- Pastor, Angela, and Ken will put together the agenda for this meeting.

Pastor Vanderhyde:

- Pastor and his family are enjoying integrating into our church, school, and the community.
- In addition to preaching and teaching, Pastor has been visiting our shut-in members, teaching middle school religion, and collaborating with school administration to look at ways to integrate the church and school.
- Working with three confirmands and families to start confirmation classes (Wednesday's 4-5 pm).
- Discussing with Elders the idea of a Wednesday night church fellowship that would include all ages.

Board of Elders: Ken Clavir, Chair

- In discussions with Pastor on Youth Program ideas.
- Confirmation will move back to 7th and 8th grade.
- Hank Thuener is stepping down as security lead. Looking for someone to lead this team.
- Christmas Staff gifts surpassed \$8,000.00. Money will be distributed soon.

School Board: Pam Clavir, Co-Chair

- The tentative date for VBS will be the week of June 10 or 17. Tori Foster has volunteered to lead VBS.
- Childcare, preschool rates, K-8 tuition, and academic fees will be increased for the next academic year.
- Reviewing and updating parent and staff handbooks.
- Spending time in classrooms to be more visible to staff and parents.
- Hired Bob Thorgesen to teach math and science at the middle school level.
- Working with PTL on community-based outreach and fundraising.
- Have requested a "cost analysis" to determine what we spend per student to educate them.
- Exploring different curriculum to raise academic rigor through all grade levels.

Treasurer: Londa Polzin, Treasurer and Cheri Carsten, Business Manager

- Monthly financial report emailed prior to meeting for review. Motion by Pam, seconded by Ken, to approve report as presented. Discussion regarding continued goal of transparency. Motion passed by voice vote.
- The council agrees with the School Board that a "cost analysis" will be beneficial and supports this request.

Business Manager: Cheri Carsten, Volunteer

- Brenda moved that we appoint Cheri Carsten as our volunteer Business Manager as outlined in our bylaws Article 3.3. Motion seconded by Ken. Discussion. Appointment approved by Pastor. Motion passed by voice vote.
- Binders with working documents of Constitution, Bylaws, and Policy manuals of Board of Elders, School Board and Church council distributed to all council members.
- Leading projects related to property. Working with McCreery and Son on heating units and maintenance.
- Had a productive meeting with Website stakeholders to maintain an updated and active website.
- Seeking a volunteer to manage the project of a new Member Directory.

Next meeting is February 10, 2024. 8:30 am.

Assignment for members: Review Church Council Policy Manual section 2 "Church Council Self-Governance Policies".

This is a draft copy of the Voters Meeting minutes that do not become official until approved by the voters.

The quarterly Congregational Assembly Meeting was called to order by President Angela Riemer at 11:47 am. Pastor Vanderhyde opened the meeting with prayer. A total of fifty-three members and one guest signed the attendance record. Minutes of the Voter's meeting from July 16, 2023, were distributed. Steve Cooper moved that the minutes be approved as written. Seconded by Wayne Hoover. Motion passed with voice vote.

Pastor Vanderhyde's Report:

- Thanked the congregation for the call and welcoming him and his family into our congregation.
- Teaching Theology classes to middle school students.
- Will begin teaching confirmation in January 2024.
- Office hours Monday – Thursday (in School).
- Communication: Email: jvanderhyde@tlgreeley.com Office: 970-330-2485 Church Cell: 970-235-0973
- Pastor's days "off" are Friday and Saturday – though he affirms that as our Pastor, he is available for spiritual care. For emergencies, please call Pastor's church cell number.
- Acknowledged our new constitution/bylaws and reminded the assembly that a constitution is designed to hold us all together. To be a voting member per our constitution, individuals must be at least 18 years of age, be a communicant member of Trinity, and have signed (have ownership of) our constitution.
- Described further what it means to be a communicant member (Article 5.1.2) – some of which are being Baptized, confirmed in the Lutheran Church, faithful attendance and partaking in the Lord's Supper often.

Elder Board: Ken Clavir, Chair

- Acknowledged the Elders who served as our call committee for their dedication and efforts.
- Holiday Service dates and times reviewed.
- Discussing how to best use the radio broadcast on KFKA.
- We need more men to serve as an Elder. Goal is one man for every twenty households.
- If God puts this on your heart, or you have questions, please contact Pastor or Ken.
- Communion will continue to be offered on the 2nd, 4th, and 5th Sunday as well as Festival Days.
- Took questions regarding number of Elders and how it is decided when to offer communion.

Treasurer: Cheri Carsten

- Presentation in paper form of Balance Sheet as of November 30, 2023. Took questions.
- Presented and discussed slides of attendance and offering analysis.
- Reminder that Profit / Loss financial reports are reviewed by Council at their monthly meeting.

School Board: Pam Clavir, Co-chair

- School has started since last meeting with many activities.
- Staff able to attend Rocky Mountain District Convention in Breckenridge.
- Our EC Director, Gwen Marshall, was honored as the EC Administrator of the Year.
- Fall Festival was attended by 400 people. Will continue this type of outreach.

- Thank you to the school staff for stepping up to help through changes and issues that arise.
- School Children's Program Sunday December 17th at 10:30 am service. Encouraged members to attend and reach out to parents.

Review of Church Organizational Chart: Angela Riemer

- Reintroduced the organizational chart that comes out of our new constitution/bylaws.
- Thanked those who have served on the Property Board and Finance Board. The property board will now be a Property Team that comes together for specific projects. Encouraged those who are willing to serve on projects to let Angela or the church office know.




