The Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) is truly blessed as supporters continue to give generously. As of this writing, offerings of \$59,000 of the \$80,000 for the RMD have been received. As of July 31, 2025 the National Mission Goal for 2025–2027 Biennium of \$2,622,270.00 has received: \$84,080. Total Mite Offerings Still Needed: \$2,760,033. As part of planning for the new year, we start the enrollment process again. Enrollment forms will be available towards the end of January. If your child is eligible for Universal PreK, you can go to their website and enroll for the 2026-27 school year (the child must be at least 4 years old before October I, 2026). We are looking to move all enrollment online to simplify the process. We are looking for ways to recruit students for preschool, elementary and the Foundry. Keep this process in your prayers. We have good things happening and want to expand our outreach and influence in our community.

2026 OFFERING ENVELOPES —are here! Numbers have changed, so *please* do not use the 2026 envelopes until Sunday, January 4th or your contributions may not be credited correctly to **YOUR** account.



Did you know: if you **do not** mark your giving envelope, all monies go into the "General Fund". If you write an amount on the line of your giving envelope for either Missions or Building Fund, those monies are accumulated and at the end of each calendar month, distributed accordingly.

- Envelopes marked with amounts for Missions allow Trinity to send nearly \$10K per year to the Rocky Mountain District for their designated missions.
- Envelopes marked Building Fund are deposited in our LCEF Building Fund each month.
 An average month can total more than \$1000.00. This money will be used to pay the mortgage if unexpected emergencies leave our cash flow in a pinch (summertime), but mostly it will go to pay down the principal on our loan.

To recap:

- *Current Expenses: goes to paying our bills: mortgage, water, electric, insurance, gas, salaries, benefits, etc.
- *Missions: goes directly to Rocky Mountain District for District named missions
- *Building Fund: is deposited in the LCEF Building Fund for building emergencies.

We give because God first gave to us! Everything we have, everything we are, are gifts from God.

If you miss picking your envelopes up on Sunday at church and want to pickup your envelopes during the week, give Debi in the office a call with at least 24 hours notice and she will have your envelopes for you to pick up at the in the school office.
