
### THURSDAY, MAY 1ST 10 AM PRAYER SERVICE

# School Happenings

#### Preschool & K-8

Trinity family,

May 21 will be school day 172 and the 2024-25 school year will be done! There were many new things (math & religion curriculum, a new teacher, new students) – many challenges – and many, many joys. I just completed my 43<sup>rd</sup> year in the teaching ministry and it's why I keep on going – the joys are much more powerful than the change and challenge. Much of that joy comes from seeing the Holy Spirit working in the lives of our staff, students and their parents.

After II weeks – which will fly by quickly – we will be back to school on August I3. We will be guided by our new principal, Pastor Vanderhyde. We will welcome a new elementary teacher – Erin Butterworth (who will teach grades 5 & 6). The early childhood staff will have an additional person because Mrs. Angela Riemer is moving away. We will have new reading curriculum materials. Our preschool will be part of the Colorado Universal PreK Program. Our elementary school will be part of the Foundry program (watch for details about that from Pastor Vanderhyde). We will also have new students in the building. It's a lot to think about, but it is exciting to be part of a ministry program that strives to improve and expand.

But our building won't be totally quiet this summer. We will still have summer preschool/childcare. The program is staffed by Mrs. Ewald, Miss Jadyn, Miss Abby and me, Miss Marshall. We have just one classroom in the summer, but it makes it easier to plan fun activities like water days and cooking projects. Summer is also a time for extended recess time; pray that we don't get a lot of heat or mosquitos this year! Otherwise, we will spend most of our time in the preschool classrooms in the southeast corner of the building.

Pray for all of our staff to have a refreshing summer – especially the ones who still work at Trinity or other places during the summer months. Let everyone "fill their buckets" to be ready when August rolls around.

Continue to pray for more students and families. I just finished giving a preschool tour before sitting down to write this. The family was very impressed with our facility, the people they met and our program. They were also excited when I told them we have an elementary school so their little boy could continue a Lutheran education when he was ready for kindergarten. They hadn't realized that a school was even here!

On a personal note – I have friends throwing a 65<sup>th</sup> birthday party for me on Saturday, June 7, beginning at 1:00 p.m. I asked that the party be at Trinity so that my church and school family can easily join the celebration. A reminder invitation will be in the bulletin as the date gets closer, but put it on your calendar now.

# RESOURCE CENTER — BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN MOTHER'S DAY TO FATHER'S DAY 2025

The annual fundraiser benefitting The Resource Center (TRC), and their valuable work in Greeley, and its surrounding communities is about to begin. This campaign helps to fund TRC as they continue to provide help (at no charge) to women who don't know which option to take. They are a Christian organization that shares Christ's love with all who will listen.

Recently TRC shared their goals for the coming year. They include:

- 1. To expand our current services (adding one evening clinic per week to include our usual medical services; parenting classes, and abortion recovery support groups; research housing options for clients who need them, and explore the idea of a "pop-up" clinic once a month in various parts of the Weld County)
- 2. Encourage more adoptions
- 3. Strengthen our partnerships with churches to include training for church housed "Embrace Grace Groups" and abortion recovery support groups
- 4. Increased engagement with younger generations especially millennial and Gen Z.

You might be wondering how much does is cost to provide assistance to one TRC client. Pregnancy test, STD test/treatment, and an ultrasound per client costs \$1357.00. Last year Trinity donated \$10,074. That equates to almost 7.5 ultrasounds provided by our community.

Please consider giving to this organization so that they can continue to provide for our community. Sadly, our laws in Colorado continue to make it too easy and acceptable to take the other option. For additional information, contact Londa Polzin, 970-656-3499.




