II. NEW BUSINESS

IV. ACTIONS: Community Engagement Committee established.

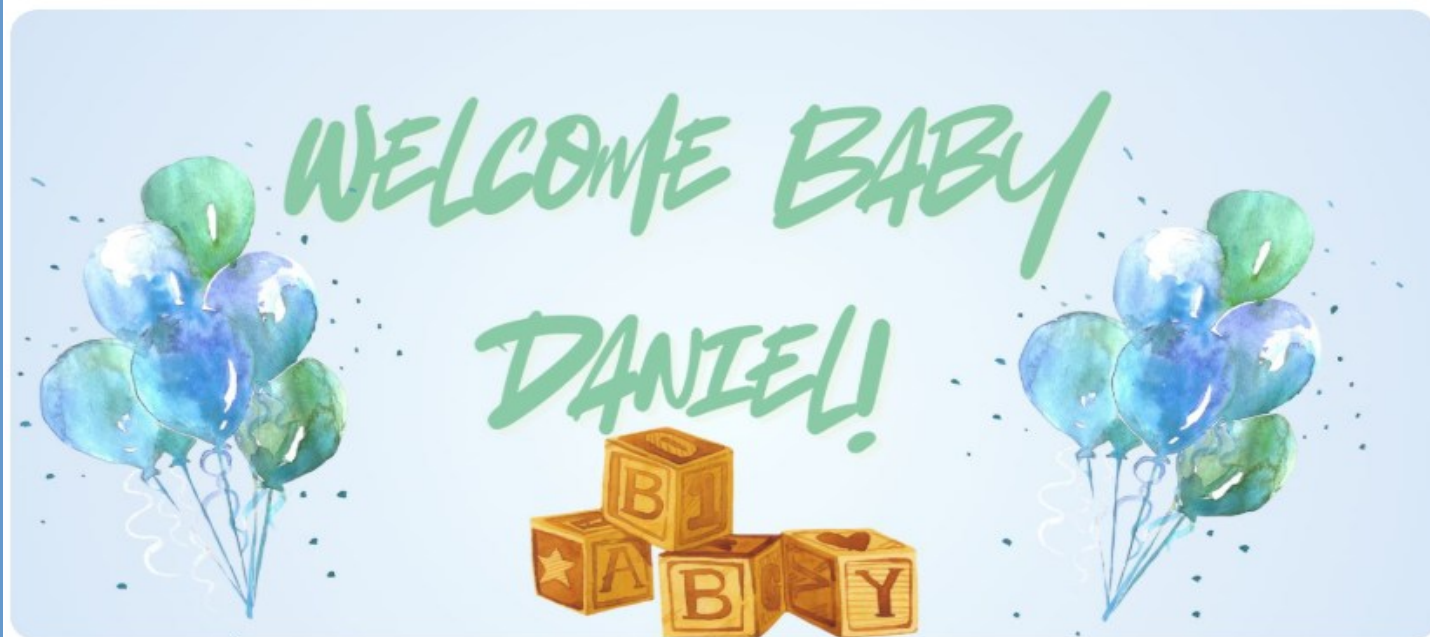

Celebrating a New Chapter for Debi

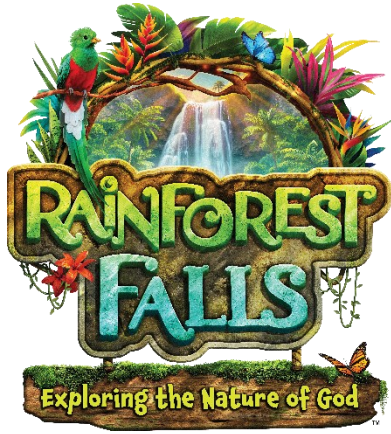
As many of you know, Debi Roethemeyer is retiring the first of June.

The annual fundraiser benefitting The Resource Center (TRC) and their valuable work in Greeley and surrounding communities will begin on Mother’s Day and end on Father’s Day. This is the second largest fundraiser of the year for TRC. This campaign helps to fund the valuable work they do. Providing no charge assistance to women as they navigate through maternity into motherhood.

TRC services include ultrasounds, medical services, parenting classes, and abortion recovery support groups. In addition, the staff provides counseling to women who don’t know what their options are. Most importantly they will share the gospel with those who are willing to listen.

Last year the members of Trinity Lutheran Church contributed \$12,739.39. The cost associated with TRC services is roughly \$1400 per client. Our donations paid for services for 9 women. That is wonderful!!! The campaign total was \$150,589.28.
