

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In our world, belonging is often something we choose and un-choose. We join groups, cancel subscriptions, and move on when something no longer meets our needs. But the Church is different. Scripture describes it not as a club or a service provider, but as a body—Christ's body—of which each of us is a living member (1 Corinthians 12).

That means we do not merely attend church; we belong to one another. When one member suffers, all suffer together. When one rejoices, all share the joy. The hand cannot say to the foot, "I have no need of you." Each part matters. Each carries responsibility for the health of the whole.

Saint Paul urges us to "maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:3). Unity is a gift from God, but it also requires care and attentiveness. Like the human body, the body of Christ grows strong when its members stay connected and responsive—when each part listens both to the Head, who is Christ, and to the other members around it.

Listening is one of the deepest forms of love. It is how we honor one another's place in the body, how we learn what another member needs, and how the Spirit brings understanding where there has been strain. When we stop listening, the body loses coordination and trust. But when we listen patiently and speak with grace, the whole body moves again with steadiness and purpose.

In the weeks ahead, I invite us to do this work together—to listen, to pray, and to care

intentionally for one another. Let's take the time to hear each other's joys and burdens, to speak words that build up, and to seek Christ's leading as one people. As we do, we will find that He is already at work among us, holding us together and making us whole.

- Thank you to Pastor for securing a \$15,000 donation to use in the Kindergarten classroom.
- Have had three successful fundraisers this fall. Fall festival is coming up.

Gwen Marshall

Early Childhood Director at Trinity-Greeley RM District Early Childhood Consultant

My name is Gwen Marshall. I'm originally from western Nebraska, but my family moved to Fort Collins in the late 70's. Colorado became my summer home when I was in college.

I'm a graduate of St. John's College, Winfield, KS< and this is my 44th year as an educator (40 of them have been in Lutheran schools). My first call was to First Lutheran in Ponca City, OK, then I became part of the start-up staff at Tulsa Lutheran School.



In 1985, I moved to the Rocky Mountain District. My next call was to Mt. Zion in Boulder. While I was there, I became part of the RMD School Ministry Committee and have served with that group for all but 5 of the past 37 years. I have the privilege of representing our District at synodical events as the Early Childhood Consultant. I have also been very involved as a captain and consultant for National Lutheran School Accreditation.

I was director/teacher at Trinity Lutheran in Denver for 25 years. In my final years there, I had the privilege of having "grand-students" – children of my former students. I also had over a dozen former preschool students come work for me when they were in high school or college.

In 2018, I moved to Greeley to be nearer my family and joined the staff of Trinity Lutheran Church & School. I'm still a teaching director – so there are still lots of challenges to keep me fresh and engaged. My current big project is getting Colorado Shines to recognize National Lutheran School Accreditation as an alternate method of getting a quality rating. As soon as that happens, I will lead my school through the latest version of the NLSA early childhood instrument.

Shortly after I moved to Greeley, all of my family members moved away. I still love Colorado and have a wonderful circle of friends here and want to stay forever. I fill any free time with cooking or following my favorite sports teams. In homage to my childhood home, I still wear red most Saturdays and follow the football and volleyball teams. I was a Rockies season ticket holder for 25 years. I love the Colorado Avalanche and have been to all three Stanley Cup Champion parades (and I need another one in 2026).


